### *Liturgy*

- **ALTAR SERVERS** boys and girls through high school.
- **ART AND WORSHIP ENVIRONMENT** plans and executes the décor for the liturgical feasts and seasons
- **CHILDREN'S LITURGY OF THE WORD** members take the smaller children to the Providence Room during 11:00 am Mass.
- **COMMUNION TO THE SICK** Eucharistic Ministers bring Holy Communion to the sick.
- **EUCHARISTIC ADORATION** and/or assisting on Tuesday mornings.
- **EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS** Commissioned men and women assist in the distribution of the Body and Blood of Christ.
- **GREETERS** welcome parishioners & newcomers to church.
- **LECTORS** Proclaim the Word of God to the parish family.
- **SACRISTANS** care for the sanctuary, sacristy, sacred vessels, altar linens, vestments and floral arrangements.
- **USHERS** Take up church collection and escort elderly to pews.
- **WORSHIP COMMITTEE** Parishioners and representatives of parish groups plan our parish worship events and seasons.

### *Music*

### *Administration and Finance*

- **CHURCH CLEANERS** clean the church weekly and before major feasts. Call Doris Mantia 842-0280.
- **FINANCE COMMITTEE** assists the pastor and the Parish Council in developing the annual budget.
- **GROUNDS KEEPERS** plan and plant flowerbeds and plantings on the church grounds.
- **MAINTENANCE** Painting, decorating, minor repairs
- **TABULATORS** count collections and prepare the bank deposit.

### *Communication and Outreach*

- **BEREAVEMENT COMMITTEE** meet with families and assist with planning funeral liturgy.
- **FRIENDLY VISITOR** visits and phone calls offer peace of mind and opportunities to those unable to participate regularly in parish life.
- **MARTHAS** Teams prepare a dish and provide a luncheon for families after a funeral.
- **PARISH NEWSLETTER** The **Spirit of Providence** is published 6 times per year for parishioners and alumni. Contributors for parish news and photography at events and services.
- **PARISH NURSE** coordinates programs and services that improve the spiritual, emotional, and physical health of all parishioners.
- **REACH OUT SHARING PROGRAM** asks parishioners to donate food and cash, and by periodically delivering the donations to Sts. Teresa and Bridget.
- **ST. PATRICK CASSEROLE PROGRAM** supplies casseroles on a monthly schedule to St. Patrick's Center for the homeless.
- **ST. VINCENT DE PAUL SOCIETY** seeks, in a spirit of justice and charity, and by person-to-person involvement, to help those in need within our parish boundaries.

### *Social Groups*

- **FIFTY PLUS CLUB** shares interests, friendship, spirituality, cultural enrichment.
- **MEN'S CLUB** promotes the spiritual, cultural and social life of the men of the parish.
- **QUILTERS** create quilts for the "Quilt of the Month Club."
- **ST. ANN SODALITY** sponsors the Marthas, The Quilters; the Annual Christmas Cookie Sale; and Annual Day of Recollection; and other spiritual and social activities throughout the year.

### *Adult Formation*

- **ACTS RETREATS** (for men and for women) ACTS: Adoration, Community, Theology and Service. A retreat weekend conducted mostly by laypeople.
- **ADULT COMPUTER MINISTRY** uses Technology Room at our school to teach computer basics to the adults who want to improve their skills. Call our Technology teacher, Mary Lynch 842-2073 to sign up.
- **31 CLUB FOR VOCATIONS** involves people signing up to specifically pray for religious vocations. Call Charlie Howard 849-6343.

- **LITTLE ROCK BIBLE STUDY** short weekly courses on various books or themes of the scripture for people who want to learn more about the Bible and faith.
- **JOURNEY INTO FAITH (R. C. I. A.)** information on Catholic beliefs and practices for anyone curious about our faith.
- **PRO LIFE COMMITTEE** promotes greater respect for the sanctity of all human life from birth to natural death.
- **WHITE HOUSE RETREAT** is operated by the Jesuits. Retreats for men and women are offered throughout the year.
- **PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION – PSR** helps public school and home-school students Grades 1 through 8 learn their Catholic faith.
- **SCHOOL VOLUNTEERS (OASIS)** help in the cafeteria or kitchen, serve as readers for children, playground supervisors or helpers in the library or school office, etc.
- **VACATION BIBLE SCHOOL** teens and adults lead this one-week program for grades 1 on up
- **YAA – YOUTH ACTIVITIES ASSOCIATION** supports social and athletic activities for school-aged children. Coaches, managers, referees are encouraged to participate.
- **YOUTH MINISTRY** – Support and encourage the parish youth ministry with supplies or participation at occasional retreats, events and meetings.

#### *Annual Events*

- **ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL** takes place each May throughout the entire archdiocese. Parish chairperson, and a large number of volunteers are needed to solicit donations from fellow parishioners. Call the parish office 843-3570.
- **GIVING TREE** During Advent parishioners take a tag “ornament” from the tree and purchase the item. All gifts go to Sts. Joachim and Ann Parish in Old Mines and are distributed by the Rural Parish Workers.
- **PROVIDENCE FEST** is held at the end of September to increase funds for the parish, build community spirit, and have fun as a parish family.
- **RACHEL MUETH GOLF TOURNAMENT** held on the first Sunday of June. Golfing plus a silent and oral auction and a gala dinner. Men and women welcome. The proceeds benefit Our Lady of Providence School.

#### *Youth*

- **BOY SCOUTS** begins with 6th grade.
- **CUB SCOUTS** (boys from the 2nd through 5th grade)
- **GIRL SCOUTS/BROWNIES** Brownies (grades 1-3), Juniors (grades 4-6), and Cadettes (grades 7 & 8)
- **PARENTS OF PROVIDENCE – P.O.P** promotes communication and cooperation between school and home.
- **PARISH SCHOOL BOARD** seven elected and two appointed members advise the Pastor as to policies governing the parish grade school.
